Why a European Games?



- Europe was only continent not to have its own multi sport Games pre 2015
- Number of Olympic medals won by Europe was continuously reducing:
 - Seoul 1988 Europe won over 70% of Olympic medals
 - Beijing 2008 Europe won less than 40% of Olympic medals
- Success of Baku 2015 clear from athletes perspective:
 - 50 Gold, 50 Silver and more than 100 Bronze Rio 2016 Olympic medals were won by athletes who won medals in Baku 2015

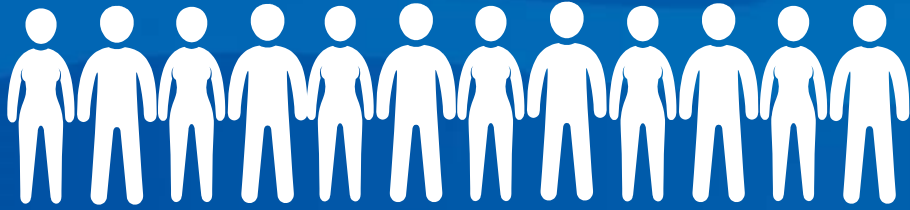

10 Sports are the Part of the 2020 Summer Olympics Qualification System:

- **Archery** – Ranking points
- **Athletics** – Qualification standards
- **Badminton** – Ranking points
- **Boxing** – Ranking points
- **Canoe Sprint** – The winners in C1 Men 1000m, C2 Men 1000m & C1 Women 200m, C2 Women 500m Olympic events
- **Cycling** – Ranking points
- **Judo** – Ranking points
- **Karate** – Ranking points
- **Shooting** – The winners in each individual Olympic event
- **Table Tennis** – Three medalists in the Men's and Women's Singles events, gold medalists in Men's and Women's Team events, gold medalists in Mixed Doubles events

Athletes' Village



- Capacity: over 6,000 athletes and officials;
- 9 residential buildings;
- Total of 3862 rooms;
- A typical accommodation unit will comprise a 50 sq.m. twobedroom apartment for 4 residents;
- Refurbishments, temporary structures and overlay completed by the end of April 2019.

Start of the ticket sales is planned on **1 December 2018**;

- minsk2019.ticketpro.by is already available for news subscription;
- sales to the general public will be conducted by MEGOC though minsk2019.ticketpro.by in the territory of Belarus and through Official Resellers on their territories starting from 1 December 2018 until 28 February 2019;
- tickets will go on sale worldwide to the general public on 1 March 2019 at www.minsk2019.ticketpro.by;
- general public will also be able to buy tickets offline in the City Ticket Outlets and Venue Ticket Box Offices as well as in more than 400 Partnership Sales Outlets around Belarus.

10 June - 10 July 2019 года

A VISA-FREE TRAVELER MUST HAVE:

- 1 Valid passport
- 2 Medical insurance of 10.000 euro (can be purchased on site)
- 3 Daily monetary allowance – at least 2 base amounts* for each day of stay













































































Citizens of 74 countries can stay in Belarus without visa for thirty days, including the arrival and departure days
