## Type D Visa for participating in sports/cultural activities

Type D long-term visa for participating in sports / cultural activities (valid for 1 year allowing to stay up to 90 days within a year) is issued for partaking in sports or cultural events.

Apart from a <u>duly completed visa application form</u>, <u>valid passport</u>, <u>one photograph</u>, <u>a letter from insurance company</u> the following visa support document is required:

An original letter of invitation of a legal entity in Belarus, issued on the letterhead with the full name of the entity, its location and telephone number, and the commitment of the legal entity that the foreigner shall comply with the rules of stay in the Republic of Belarus, sealed by the legal entity.

or

A document confirming the need of multiple trips within the declared period, e.g. a copy of a contract or cooperation agreement between a Belarusian legal entity and the applicant or a foreign organization by which he/she is employed

Please, kindly note that the consular official may request additional documents, other than those specified in the foregoing, confirming the information contained in the visa application form and/or the letter of invitation. Refusal to provide the requested documents may lead to withholding a permit to enter Belarus.
